- 3- The applicant has obtained a minimum score of (5) in the IELTS English language test or its equivalent.
- 4- It is preferred that the applicant has practical or voluntary experience in the field of specialization or experience in scientific research.
- 5- Submitting a personal statement explaining the reason for the applicant's desire to study a specific sub-specialty, and what skills and experiences the applicant possesses to qualify the applicant to study the chosen sub-specialty.
- 6- To be of good conduct and medically fit.
- 7- Pay the application fee (non-refundable).
- 8- Passing the admission test and personal interview.
- 9- Pay tuition fees.
