## TERMS:

**1- The applicant must have a bachelor's degree in the field of dentistry and surgery from an entity recognized by the ministry of education, with a grade of no less than good.**

**2- The applicant must obtain a score of (85) in the TOEFL test or its equivalent.**

**3- Obtaining a valid license to practice the profession from Saudi commission for health specialties.**

**4- Passing the internship year.**

**5- The approval of the employer.**

**6- The student should not be registered during the program in any other country for postgraduate studies or private clinics.**

**7- Must be of good conduct and medically fit.**

**8- Pay the application fee (non-refundable).**

**9- Passing the admission test and the personal interview.**

**10- Pay tuition fees.**

**1- Graduation document and academic record for the undergraduate level.**

**2-Status card (national identity for Saudis) and passport or residence permit (for non-Saudis)**

**3- English language test result.**

**4- (3) recommendations from the arbitrators.**

**5-CV (updated).**

**6-Employer approval letter.**

**7- License to practice the profession.**
