2-Applicant must obtain a score of (85) in the TOEFL test or its equivalent.

3-Obtaining a valid license to practice the profession from the Saudi commission for health specialties.

4-Passing the internship year

5-Approval of the employer

6-Must be good conduct and medically fit.

7-Pay the application fee (non-refundable).

8-Passing the admission test and personal interview

9-Pay tuition fees.
